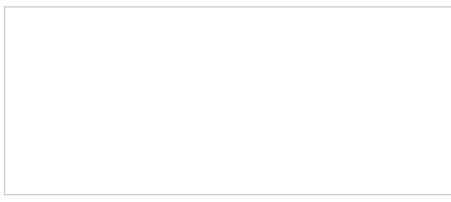
From O'Hare Airport

From Downtown Chicago
 I-290 West (Eisenhower Expressway) to I-88 (East West to Aurora). Exit I-88 at 83 North (1st exit after toll booth). At stoplight (22nd Street), turn right. Go three stop lights to Jorie Boulevard. Turn right. Jorie Blvd. to second stop light (Kroc Drive). Turn left. At stop sign turn left on Ronald Lane. Hotel is on left and parking is on right.

From I-294 South
 I-294 North to I-88 (West to Aurora). Exit I-88 at 83 North (1st exit after toll booth). At stop light (22nd Street), turn right. Go three stop lights to Jorie Boulevard. Turn left. At stop sign turn left on Ronald Lane. Hotel is on left and parking is on right.

I-355 from North or South to I-88 from West
 From either direction to I-88 exit (East to Chicago). I-88 to Midwest Road. Exit at light (Midwest Road). Turn left. Midwest Road to 31st Street (next light).
